Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like you to know that our school is participating this year in a 'Building Bridges' project, organised by our local sport partnership.

As part of the project, Connor, Isabella and Yianni from Year 6 have been invited to visit Amwell View School on four occasions, to support their children in PE lessons. Amwell View is a special school providing outstanding provision for children with many complex needs, including a range of severe disabilities.

Last Tuesday, I accompanied the children on their first visit. To start with, we were taken on a tour around the school; the facilities were excellent. The sensory room and the heated swimming pool were our favourites.

Afterwards, our children were asked to give support during dance and games lessons.

Overall, although at times the task seemed daunting, we are very happy that we got involved in such a rewarding project. We are looking forward to the remaining sessions.
