IMPLEMENTATION – How do we achieve our aims?

Planning:

At Christ Church, French is taught using **Language Angels**, following the National Curriculum. Lessons build progressively, helping children develop confidence in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Interactive activities and cultural learning make French engaging, practical, and enjoyable.

Recording:

Children's learning in French is supported through recorded lessons and books, providing evidence of both speaking and listening skills. They are given opportunities to read words, sentences, and longer extracts, as well as to develop their writing skills through structured activities. This approach ensures balanced practice across all areas of language learning.

Assessment:

We use Language Angels' built-in assessments to track our progress in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. These assessments give us immediate feedback and help us see how well we are meeting our learning goals, supporting our development in French in a clear and structured way.

Vocabulary:

We use Language Angels to build and expand our French vocabulary. The program introduces new words in context and gives us opportunities to practice speaking, reading, and writing them. This helps us remember the words more effectively and use them confidently in sentences and conversations.

EYFS: In the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), children focus on developing general language awareness and communication skills through songs, rhymes, and play. They begin learning a modern foreign language, specifically French, in Key Stage 2, where they build listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. This structured approach helps them extend their vocabulary, form sentences, and gain confidence in using French in a variety of contexts.

Lesson Structure:

At Christ Church, all lessons follow a consistent 7-part structure designed to support high-quality teaching, clear learning routines, and strong pupil progress. This approach ensures that every lesson has a purposeful flow — from activating prior knowledge to celebrating new learning.

SEND:

In MFL, children with SEND are supported to develop their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills at their own pace. Learning is made accessible through visual aids, songs, games, and practical activities, helping them understand and use new vocabulary and simple phrases. Individual support and differentiation ensure that every child can participate confidently, enjoy the language, and make progress according to their abilities.
