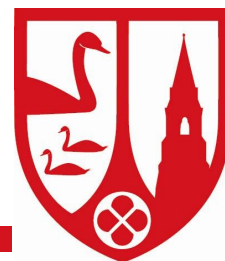

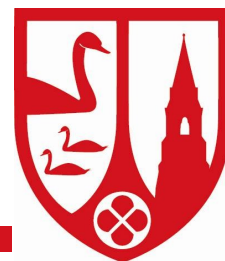

Active Prayer

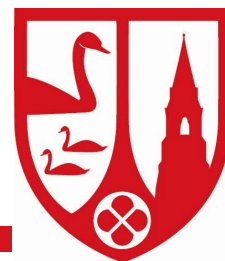
This week marks the start of advent, attached is a document sharing the joy of Christmas. Take some time with your loved ones to look through it and see what answers you come up with to the questions.
