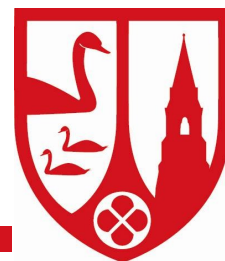

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I just want to start by saying thank you to all of you for using the new gate code this week. The aim is to improve site security and I think it is working well. We have slightly adjusted the timings on the gate for the early risers and the late comers to Cafe Play so it should be smoother moving forward.
